Change Fees Explained

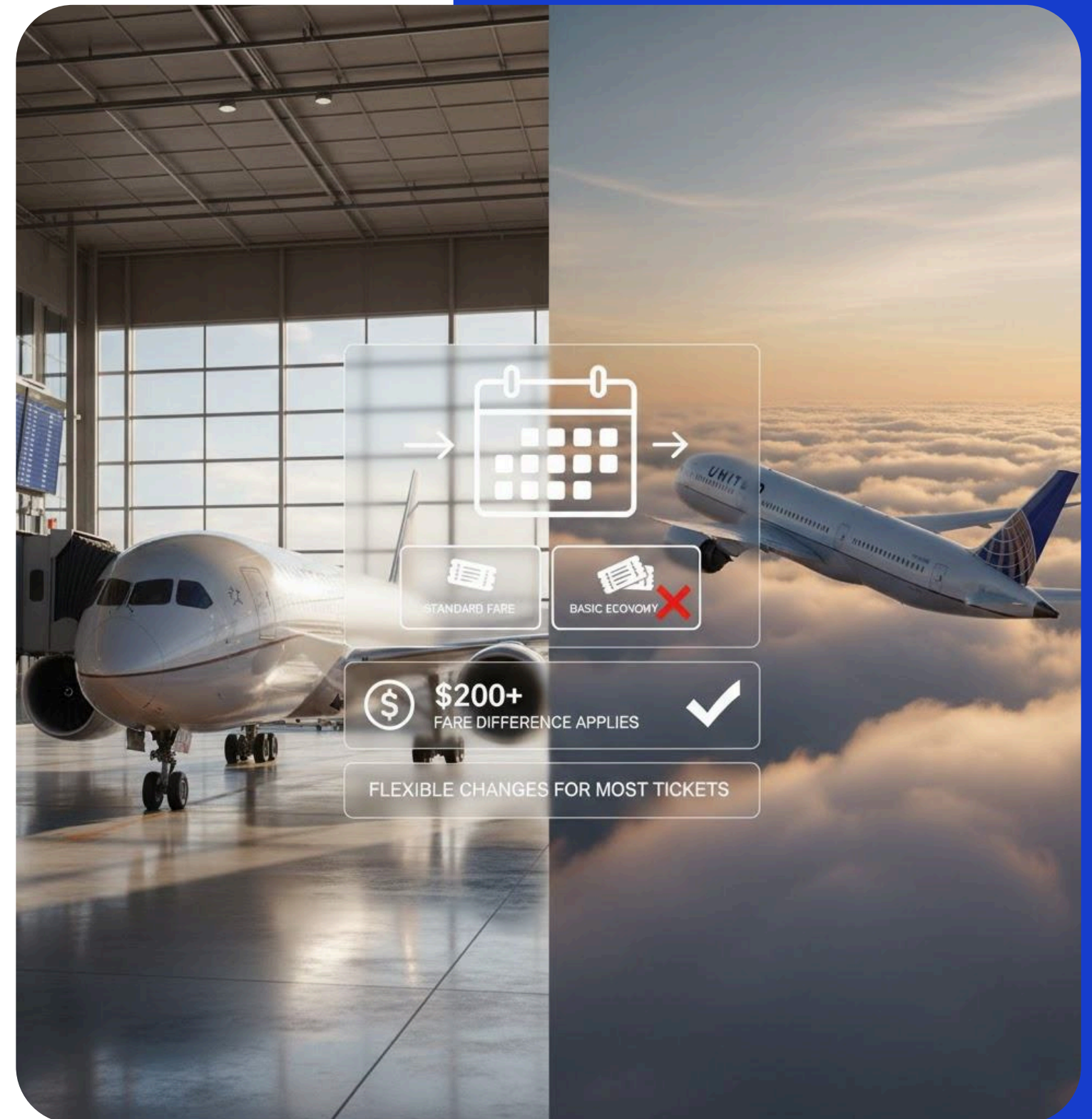
Under the **United Airlines Changes Flight Policy**:

Request same-day flight changes

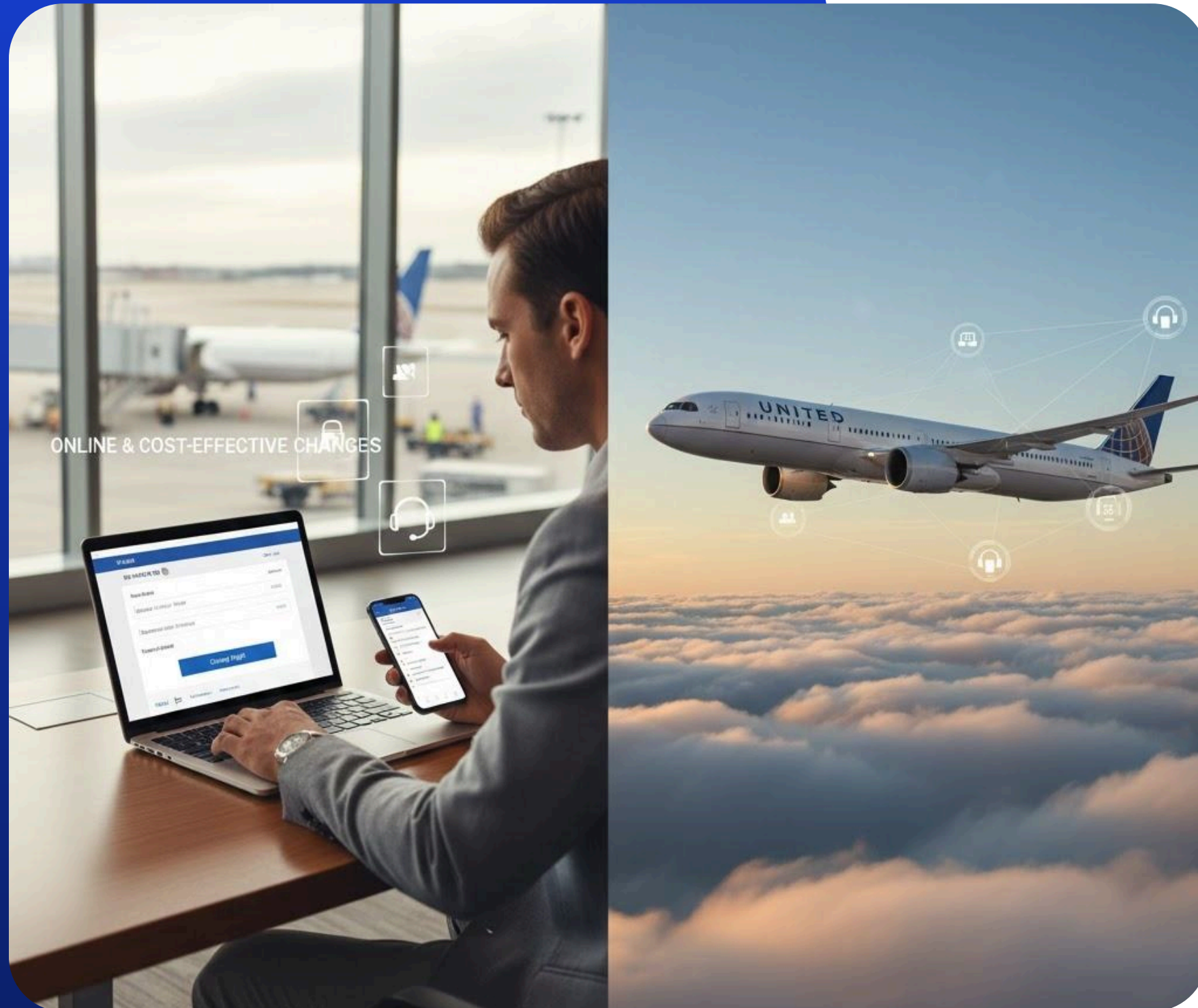
Switch to earlier or later flights on the same route

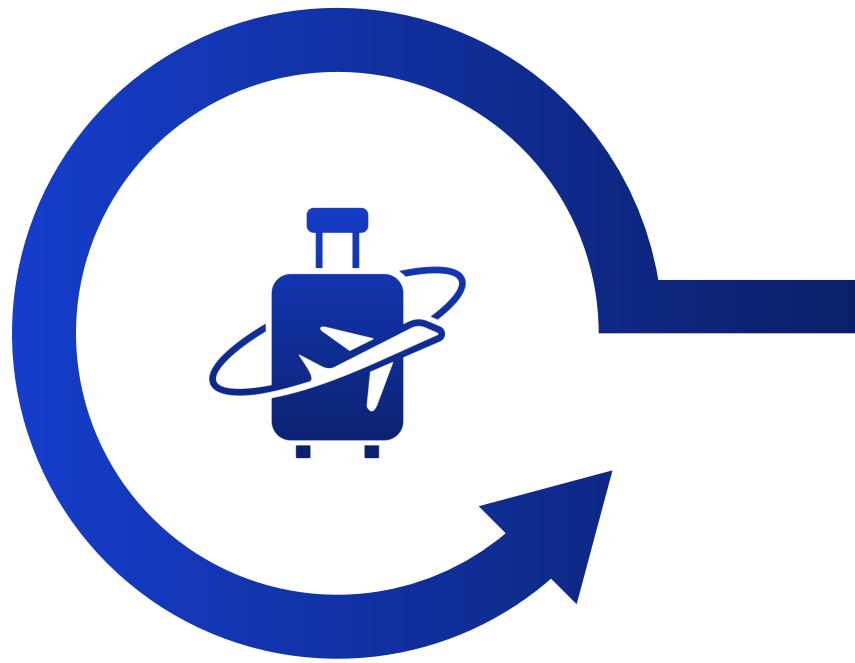

Tips to Avoid Extra Charges

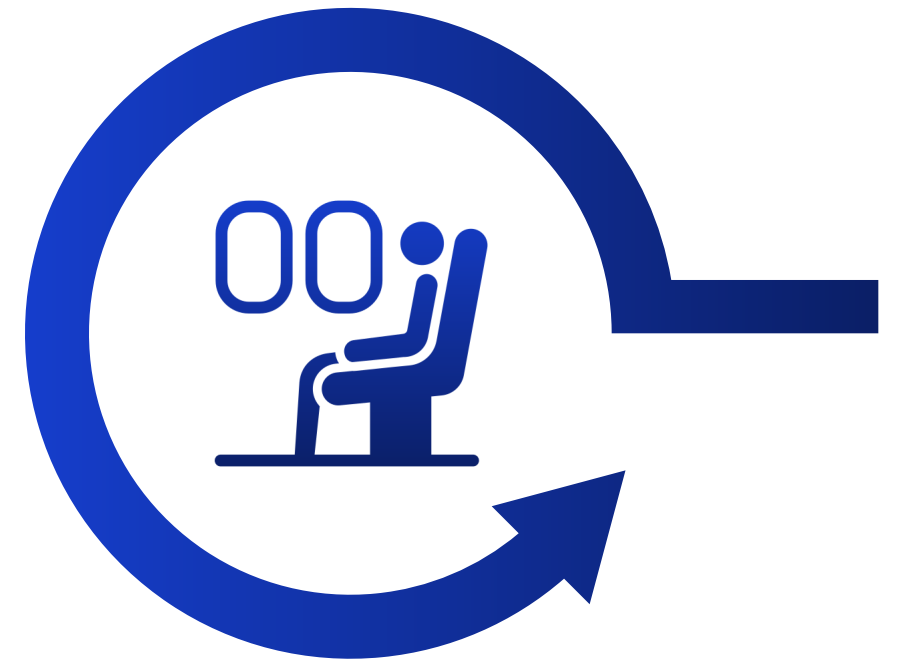
To benefit from the **United Airlines Changes Flight Policy**:
